# **Outdoor Games**

# Here are some specific games you can try:

# Scavenger Hunt:

Before the hike, create a list of natural items for hikers to find (e.g., a smooth rock, a red leaf, a pinecone).

# I Spy:

One person spots an object and says, "I spy with my little eye something..." (and adds a descriptive clue, like color).

# Twenty Questions:

One person thinks of a person, place, or thing, and others ask yes/no questions to guess it.

#### Alphabet Game:

Choose a category (like animals or plants) and go through the alphabet, naming items within that category.

#### Nature BINGO:

Create BINGO cards with nature-themed images or words, and mark them off as you spot them on the trail.

#### Trail Hide and Seek:

One person hides along the trail while others seek them.

#### Count Them All:

Choose a specific item (e.g., a certain type of tree, a specific bird) and count how many you see along the way.

#### Hide a Friend:

Bring a small toy or stuffed animal and hide it along the trail for others to find.

# Predator-Prey:

One person is the predator (e.g., a fox) and the other is the prey (e.g., a rabbit), and they move through the trail as the "hunt".

### Follow the Leader:

One person leads the way, setting the pace and direction, and others follow.
